Friis is a Sarnia born bowler (maiden name Clendenning) who picked up her bowling skills coming up through the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling program in the late sixties. She has a very impressive resume when it comes to her performance on the lanes. She is a right handed competitor who has bowled on the Women's Senior Team Canada for 6 years (2013 – 2015 – 2016 – 2017 – 2018 – 2019). She has also qualified for the 2020 team. Her Team Canada accomplishments in the World Championships (WC) and the Pan American Bowling Congress (PABCON) Championships are as the following: 2013 – WC – Team – Silver, 2016 – PABCON – Trios –Gold, Doubles – Silver - All

Events – Silver, 2017 – WC – Doubles –Gold - Team – Silver and 2018 – PABCON – Singles – Gold. She also has 5 Bronze medals during these years. Her other accomplishments include 2016 – Canadian Women's Bowler Of The Year, 2019 – Ladies winner of the Jack Erb Ontario Provincial Senior Handicap Tournament in the 55-59 division which qualified her to bowl in the United States Bowling Congress Championship Women's Senior Handicap Division in Cincinnati where she ended up 5<sup>th</sup> out of 33 bowlers (having the top scratch score for 9 games), 2019 – Canadian Team Trials Women's Senior gold medalist and she has been the London And District Women's Bowler Of The Year 19 times. She has a career 8-300's and 2-800's to her credit. Friis is a member of the team "Travelling Biotches" in the TNLL team with fellow bowlers Karen MacNeil and Judy Hansen all from the London Area.



**Legault sisters fight for second and third spots:**

Melissa Legault tossed 676 (234-218-224) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League (TNLL) at Marcin Bowl to take the ladies second high triple of the week in LCTA activity. Legault is a graduate of the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program. She has 14 sanctioned 300's to her credit in Canadian/American league and tournament competition. She has numerous 700's including a 798, 799 and a couple 790's. She has 2 sanctioned 800's (817-812) to her credit both bowled in Port Huron. Melissa holds the honor as the only woman to record 2-800's in the Port Huron Bowling Association history. She is currently averaging 218 after 12 games in the TNLL.



Karyne Legault rolled 669 (206-234-229) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League (TNLL) at Marcin Bowl to take third spot in the ladies high triple department for the week. Karyne started 10 pin bowling at the age of four coming up through Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl youth bowling programs and the YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program at Northgate Bowl. Her bowling accomplishments include victories in the 2002 YBC Nationals in New Brunswick, 2005 CYC (Christian Youth Camps) Nationals in British Columbia, 2009 CYC Nationals In Winnipeg and 2010 Team Canada in Finland. She has 1-300 to her credit and her high triple is 797. She is another great bowler that has come up through the youth bowling programs at Marcin Bowl, Hi-Way Bowl and the now deceased Northgate Bowl, Lakeside Bowl, Echo Lanes, Mitton Street Bowl and Airey Lanes.

**Smith posts personal top triple:**

Connor A Smith fired 659 (263 – 94 pins over average - 221 – 152 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to record his personal highest triple. Smith did not come up through a youth bowling



program. He started league bowling last year with his close friends in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl. He finished with a 156 average for 78 games in the TNML last year. The twenty-seven year old had only previously casually bowled with friends once a year but was looking for a winter sport. He was interested with bowling when one of his friends was looking at putting a team together to do some league bowling. This year the team is bowling in the BCML. He is presently averaging 174 after 30 games with a personal high 268 single game. His summer activities include lacrosse (playing and coaching), two pitch softball and following that little white ball on the golf course.

### **Jean is tops for the youth:**



Hollie-Anne Jean tossed 623 (201 – 232 - 63 pins over average - 118 pins over average for three games) in the Youth Intermediate Division at Marcin Bowl to register the youth high triple of the week. Last week she rolled her personal highest triple (626) and single game (257). Her previous high scores were 625 and 248. Hollie has been with the Marcin Bowl Junior Program (MBJP) for approximately thirteen years and this year she is averaging 173 for 27 games. Last she finished with a 172 average for 78 games.

### **McKechnie is 100 pins over average:**

Terry McKechnie bowled 268 - 101 pins over average in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to post the week's high over average for a single game. McKechnie is a relatively new bowler only in his third year of sanctioned league bowling. This year he is averaging 172 after 24 games. Last year in the BMNML he finished the year with a 176 average for 78 games. In his first year, he participated in the Sarnia Marcin Aamjiwnaang Mixed League finishing the year with a 167 for 99 games.
