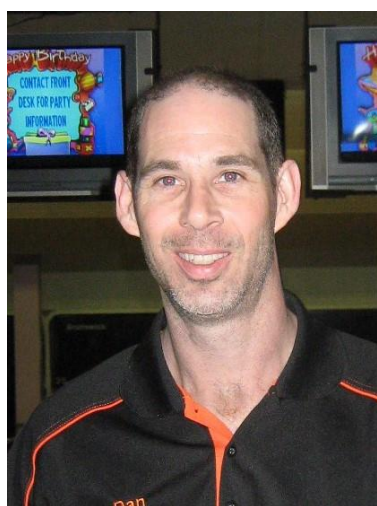

Dan Chopp tossed 744 (290 – 11 in a row – 243) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to record the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association bowling action this week. Chopp, a strong smooth rolling right handed bowler, is off to a great start this year averaging 231 (18 games) after six weeks on the lanes. His final averages for the last eight years in the BCML in descending order were 215-219-223-221-228-226-225 and 225.

Pinel Slaughters the pins:



Ryan Pinel had a SUPER day in the Marcin Youth Tenpin Junior Division on Saturday at Marcin Bowl as he mercilessly slaughtered the pins. He posted his career personal highest triple and single game. Ryan rolled 679 (246 – 94 pins over average – 276 – 124 pins over average - 224 pins over average for three games) on lanes 21 & 22 to take ownership of the Youth high triple and single of the week. The 152 average bowler raised his average 14 pins with his SUPER performance. Ryan started bowling at age 6 in 2011 in the Marcin SMAA Youth Bowling program. The thirteen year old kegler has had considerable

success in earning scholarship money in the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association Youth Tournaments (OTBAYT). In 2015, he and his doubles partner Braeden Scott, won the OTBAYT Doubles Event in St. Catharines.
