## **Lewicki leads the way:**



Steve Lewicki fired 759 (247-223-289 - 10 strikes in a row ) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to lead the way in the high triple department in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. Steve is a smooth rolling lefty with an HONOUR score sheet that most competitive bowlers would like to have in their scrap book. His 20-300's and 12-800's in Canadian/United

States league and tournament action are extremely impressive. Steve recorded the only 800 series in this LCTA season (801) so far in the first week of bowling In the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl. He is averaging 225 after 78 games in the BMNML and 213 after 75 games in the RCAFA League.

**Sirois is second best:**

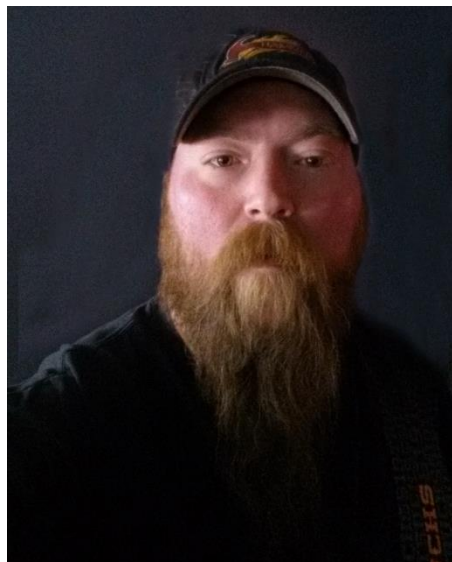
Stephane Sirois tossed 750 (248-287 – 80 pins over average -10 strikes in a row – 126 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men’s League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to record the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. Stephane takes part in three leagues this season and has been carrying a consistent average: SMML average 208 – 87 games, Marcin Border City Men’s League average 207 – 81 games and the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League average 209 - 42 games. He has 2-300’s and his highest triple is 791.

**Marciniszyn rolls into third place:**

Mike Marciniszyn rolled 746 (270-225-251) in the Sunday Morning Men’s League at Marcin Bowl to register the week’s third high triple. Mike is an example of one of the many adult bowlers who have obtained their bowling skills through Lambton County youth bowling programs over the years. He only bowls once a week but he is such a strong opponent on the lanes carrying the LCTA high average this year with 229 after 78 games. His closest challenger is Steve Lewicki with a 225 average in the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League. He has 8-300’s to his

credit but is still chasing the elusive 800 series.



**Belliveau wheels personal best single:**

Jay Belliveau wheeled 745 (290 – 96 pins over average - 11 strikes in a row – 241 – 157 pins over average for three games) in the Sunday Morning Men’s League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl to post his personal best single game and the fourth high triple of the week. He also took the honours for the LCTA high single of the week. Jay started bowling at age 6 through the Youth Bowling Canada (YBC) program at Starlite Lanes in Wallaceburg until he was 18 years old. The Tilbury resident has been knocking down the pins for 30 plus years. His sanctioned highest scores are 290 (he has 2-300’s - non - sanctioned) and 756. Jay said he has two memorable

bowling moments. His first favourite memorable accomplishment was sharing the experience with his son Sebastian in the Provincial Family Twosome Tournament in 2016 when they became provincial champions. He said “being a provincial champion with my 9 year old son was a far better feeling than any high scores I have achieved”. His other memorable moment was when he rolled his first 300 while practicing with his son after his YBC league. The once a week bowler is averaging 198 after 87 games in the SMML.

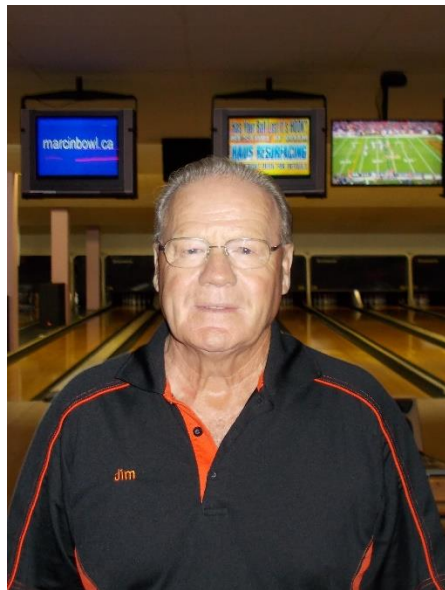
**Shephard solid on the lanes:**

Mike Shephard hurled 742 (289 - 78 pins over average – 10 strikes in a row -221-232) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the fifth high triple of the week. Mike is a graduate of the defunct Airey Lanes youth bowling program. He is a powerful right handed bowler with a ton of talent. His final averages for the last eight years in the BMNML (220-225-225-225-218-225-229-220) back up his bowling skills. This year in the BMNML he is down a bit on his average (212) after 69 games. His



HONOUR scores are also very impressive – 9-300's and 5-800's with 827 his highest.

### **Burgess tosses personal high triple:**



Jim Burgess had a super night as he tossed 705 (206-231-268 – 98 pins over average – 195 pins over average for three games) in the Target Trios Mixed League (TTML) at Hi-Way Bowl. It was his personal highest sanctioned 700 plus series. His highest sanctioned single game is 299. Jim is a late comer to 10 pin bowling as he started knocking the pins down at age 55 and has been bowling for 21 years. Jim bowls full time in two leagues: the Marcin Border City Men's League (averaging 175 – 90 games) and the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (averaging 175 – 78 games). He also spares in the TTML, the Marcin

Thursday Night Men's League and the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League. Jim also enjoys going to the out of town tournaments (Provincials and Seniors Single/Doubles tournaments) with the usual gang.

### **Trott is tops for the youth:**



Joshua Trott fired 690 (207-278– 86 pins over average– 9 strikes in row – 205) in the Marcin Bowl Youth League Senior Division to take the honours for the youth high triple of the week. Joshua's highest sanctioned scores are 278 (which he tied this week) and a 715 triple which he posted last season. When off the lanes, Joshua is furthering his education at Lambton College and picking up on the job training at local nursing homes.
