Weekly Highlights

Best rolls top triple: converts "Big Four" split:

Right handed bowler Brad Best fired 750 (257-289 – 75 pins over average – 204 – 108 pins over average for three games) on lanes 11 & 12 in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Hi-Way Bowl. He took the honours for the high triple in Lambton



County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. They were his personal best scores beating his previous top scores of 746 and 287. He also spared the 4-6-7-10 split in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL). He slid the 6-10 pins over getting the 7 pin which hit the gutter and came back to trip the 4 pin. Best is bowling in two leagues this year with averages and games bowled in brackets: BCML (216 – 45 games) and the SMCL (199-51 games).



Lapointe takes high single:

Ben Lapointe tossed the first eleven solid strikes in his second game of the night. He was in the same position where he was last week in the Sunday Morning Classic League when he got robbed from registering another perfect game by a solid 8 pin. Lapointe got on the approach for his last delivery and with dead silence in the house, he tossed his final ball. Unfortunately the ball came high on the head pin leaving the 3-6-10 pins and a 297 game. He was participating in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 11 & 12 finishing the night with 725 (192-297 – 77 pins over average – 236) and the week's high single and second high triple. He now has 59-700's, a very impressive personal record for this young bowler. He is averaging 222 after 36 games in the RCAFA league this year.

**Plumb slides into third place:**

Larry Plumb hurled 712 (244-224-244) on lanes 11 & 12 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to take third place in the high triple department in LCTA bowling action this past week. He is now averaging 215



after 54 games in the SMCL this year. Plumb bowls on a 3 man with fellow bowlers George Newman and Shawn Cotterill.

Parkkila is high over average:



Kole Parkkila rolled 648 (237-231)(+141) in the Phantom Youth Intermediate Division at Hi-Way Bowl to take the honours for high over average for three games in LCTA bowling action this week. It was his personal highest triple. His highest single game is 255. Kole started enjoying the great game of 10-pin bowling at age 5 in the Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowlers League in the Bumpers Division. Kole is now 18 years

old so he has been attacking bowling pins for 13 years even though a couple of those years were 5-pins at Marcin Bowl. Parkkila gives credit to his older brother Justin who got him and his twin brother Cameron back into 10-pin bowling and gave them great tips to improve their games. The Parkkila twins also improved their games over the years under the watchful eyes of coaches Mel and Shirley Matthews. This writer is sure Uncle Jim Lapointe and Cousin Ben Lapointe probably added some good tips also to make sure they had everything they needed to grow as 10-pin bowlers.
