Weekly Highlights

Croskery is top kegler:



Jordan Croskery rolled the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition this past week. Croskery recorded 770 (268 – 59 pins over average – 255-247 – 143 pins over average for three games) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl in the Best Wiring Classic League. It was his first 700 of the season while last season he had 3-700's. Jordan has a career 2-800's (806-826) and 9-300's to his credit.

Visser posts new high scores:

Zachary Visser bowled career new high scores in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) this past week. Visser bowled 538 (224 – 86 pins over average – 163-151) on lanes 21 & 22 at Marcin Bowl. His previous high triple was 526 (138-187-201) and 201 high single which he recorded in the FTBMNML last season.



Youth bowlers record new high scores:

Youth bowlers Tayllum Taylor and Russell Davis recorded new personal high scores in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) at Marcin Bowl this past week in the LCTA.

Tayllum rolled 477 (175 – 48 pins over average – 155-147) on lanes 21 & 22 to register a new high triple beating her previous 395 (180-95-120) which she bowled



last season. Her career high single is 180. Last season Tayllum averaged 120 for 84 games in the PYL.

Russell fired 320 (86-123 – 30 pins over average – 111) on lanes 21 & 22 to record a new high triple topping his previous 298. His career high single is 131. Last season Russell averaged 79 for 80 games.

Mezzatesta is 100 pins over average:



Steve Mezzatesta wheeled 233 (101 pins over average) in his first game of the night to be 100 pins over average for a single game. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, ending the night with a 548 (155 pins over average for three games) triple. Steve's career high scores are 570 (179-245-146) and 245 which he posted in the FTBMNML last season.

Best has solid night:



Carl Best tossed 746 (269 – 87 pins over average – 257 – 75 pins over average – 220 – 200 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to post the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his first 700 of this season. Best didn't have any 700's last season but had 1-700 in the 2023-2024 season. Carl's career high scores are 778 and 300 (1987-1988 season).

Schofield good for third spot:



Lefty Kevin Schofield fired 733 (244-267 – 66 pins over average – 222 – 130 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 3rd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. It was his first 700 of the season. This writer does not know how many 700's Schofield had last season as he spent last winter in Florida. However, Kevin gave up his Florida home and is bowling in the LCTA this season. Schofield's has a career 13-800's (5 in the Canadian Tenpin Federation and 8 in Florida) and 20-300's to his credit.



Lapointe increases his lead:



Ben Lapointe rolled 713 (220-215-278 – 59 pins over average) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to record the 4th high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 5th 700 of the season and his career 148th. He increased his lead in the year's 700 race by 3 over Mike Shephard and Roy Mezzatesta. Lapointe is averaging 224 for 12 games in the SPBCML this season.

Mezzatesta Grabs last place:

Roy Mezzatesta wheeled 703 (265 – 50 pins over average – 214-224) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to record the low 700 of the week in the LCTA. It was his 2nd 700 of the season. Mezzatesta is averaging 220 after 12 games in the SPBCML this season.



Sitter is best for the ladies:



Kelly Sitter tossed 579 (198-178-203) on lanes 23 & 24 in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl to register the ladies high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action.
