Weekly Highlights

Murphy leads the way:



Chris Murphy hurled 733 (196 – 275 – 89 pins over average – 262 – 76 pins over average – 175 pins over average for three games) in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, to take the honours for the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action. It was his 2nd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 760 (235-227-298). Chris is now averaging 194 for 24 games bowling on the “AST Group” team with team members Jay Smith, Brad Best and Brandon Gauthier. Last year in the SPBCML Murphy averaged 201 for 75

games.

Ingles posts first 700 series:



Blake Ingles tossed 714 (212 – 254 – 71 pins over average – 248 – 65 pins over average – 165 pins over average for three games) in LCTA bowling play to post his first ever 700 series. The accomplishment took place in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl, giving him the 5th high triple of the week. His previous high triple was 667 (266-220-181) which he recorded last season in the MFFL. His career high single is 278. Ingles is averaging 190 for 24 games in the MFFL this season bowling on the “Incredibowls” team with team members

Victoria Thomson, Debra Thomson and Stacy Matthews. Last year in the league he averaged 184 for 93 games. Blake started bowling in 2013 at age 9 in the Youth Phantom League at Hi-Way Bowl and is in his 12th year of enjoying the great sport of 10-pin bowling.



Capes rolls personal high triple:

Eric Capes rolled 468 (169 – 60 pins over average -145 -154 – 141 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl, to record his highest triple topping his previous 421. Capes is a two-handed bowler and his highest single game is 187. Eric did not come up through an organized youth league and started bowling this year in an organized adult league at age 26. He said he got interested in 10-pin bowling through his girlfriend. Capes said, “I would come out and watch my girlfriend bowl every week so this year I decided I would join the league and have some fun too”. Eric said he used to play travel hockey and this year he played co-ed baseball and golf. His hobbies are fishing and video games. Capes is now averaging 115 for 24 games in the league bowling with team members Kylie Barnes, Rob Reid and Mike Mattsson.

Moniz nipped to second spot:

Ben Moniz fired 731 (219-244-268) in the Klean and Brite Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl, to record the 2nd high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his first 700 of the season. Ben is averaging 199 after 9 weeks bowling with team mates Siobhan McAnulty, Jayme LeNeve, Mike Farmer and Curt Cassetta. Moniz has not bowled in any sanctioned adult leagues in the LCTA since the 2012-2013 season when he was bowling in the Sunday Morning Men’s League at Marcin Bowl and finished that year with an 182 average for 90 games. This writer is unaware of Moniz’s career high scores.

Long is 100 pins over average:

Brian Long wheeled 263 in his second game of the night to be 102 pins over average for a single game and take top honours in that department this week in LCTA bowling action. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to finish with a 674 (206-263-205) triple. Long’s career high scores are 679 and 289. Mike is off to a great start in the BWCL as he is averaging 220 for 24 games. Last season in the BWCL he averaged 211 for 96 games.

TJ Kinny fired 716 (236-237-243) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action to register his first 700 this season. Last season Kinny had 2-700's. He was bowling in the Target Trios Mixed League (TTML) at Hi-Way Bowl finishing with a 541 triple. Gark's career high triple is 593 (184-243-166) which he bowled in the TTML in the 2023-2024 season. Chase, a right-handed bowler, has a career high single of 289. Gark said he started bowling at a very young age around 4 or 5 he thought, with his Bugs Bunny balling ball at Hi-Way Bowl. He bowled one season in the Marcin Bowl Youth League but after that he bowled off and on as a kid. He said he eventually got real interested in bowling from getting out on the lanes with his family especially his dad Jeff and Aunt (Anna Androski). They helped him to improve his bowling skills which made the game more interesting. He is averaging 164 after 12 games in the TTML this year. Gark's other sport interest is basketball. He played competitive basketball for many years leading up to a major head injury at the end of high school. After his injury he stayed away from contact



sports. Chase's hobbies include hunting, fishing, long range precision shooting, camping and video games.

Louie Willemssen tossed 780 (247-268-265) in the Thursday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to record the week's high triple.

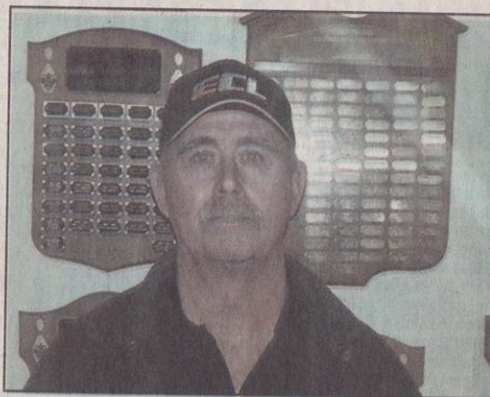
