He was participating in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl on lanes 21 & 22 finishing the night also with the week's high triple 772 (300-225-247). Jim is a right handed bowler who does not use the thumb hole. He is averaging 250 after two weeks action. It was his career 23rd 300 in LCTA, the defunct ABC (American Bowling Congress) and USBC (United States Bowling Congress) league and tournament play.
