Weekly Highlights

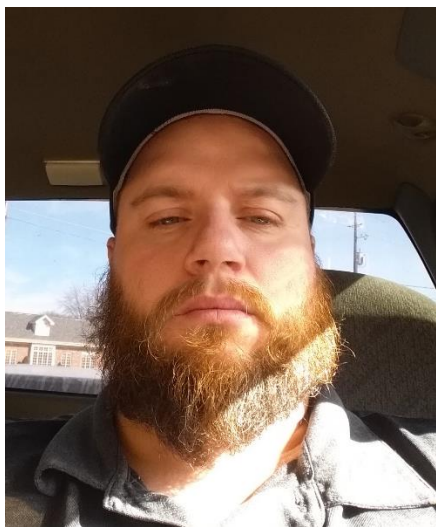
Shephard is top bowler:

Mike Shephard hurled 761 (245-268-248) on lanes 7 & 8 in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Hi-Way Bowl to register the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 10th 700 plus series this season in his two leagues. His other 700 series this season are 701-713-714-715-716-727-744-766 and 778. The hard throwing right hander is bowling in two leagues this season with his current average and games in brackets: Sunday Morning Classic League (227 – 66 games) and the BCML (219 -54 games).



Wilson a close second:

Cody Wilson wheeled 757 (279-191-278) on lanes 9 & 10 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to post the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. This writer believes it is his career personal highest triple. Wilson is averaging 206 after 45 games in the RCAFA league.

Armstrong takes third spot:

John Armstrong fired 705 (258-191-256) on lanes 11 & 12 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to record the third high triple in LCTA activity this past week. Armstrong started bowling 10 - pin at age 20 and has been enjoying his passion on the lanes for 25 years. He has 2- 300's (sanctioned), his first one coming in 2009 in Ruthven near Kingsville.

He rolled his second perfect game in December, 2018 at Chatham Bowlerama. His career highest sanctioned triple is 792. John commutes from Chatham and is in his sixth year in the Sunday morning league: 5 years in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at the recently closed Marcin Bowl and this year in the SMCL. His last 5 years of averages in the Marcin Bowl SMML



starting from the 2016-2017 season to the 2020-2021 season were 206-209-203-206 and 215. This year he is averaging 203 after 66 games. Armstrong is on a 3 man team with Rob Winder and Ralph MacDuff.

Paquette rolls first 700 series:

David Paquette experienced the excitement of achieving the first leg of the Triple Crown (300-700-800) in 10-pin bowling this past Sunday morning. The Ultimate Crown of course would also include the 900 series but it is a rare accomplishment that no Canadian bowler has ever achieved. He



tossed 704 (227-242-235) on lanes 11 & 12 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to register his career first 700 series in LCTA bowling action. Paquette started bowling at age 12 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program and remained in the league for 5 years under the watchful eyes of coaches Gil and Carol Jean. The 28 year old right hander has been knocking down the pins ever since, with a break for a few years when he attended college. He got interested in bowling because he comes from a bowling family with his grandfather and father being avid bowlers over the years. “Even before I started bowling, I would go and watch my father perform on the lanes” he said. He is just bowling in the SMCL this year but also bowled for a few years in the



Monday Night Men's League before Marcin Bowl closed. His career high single is 290 when he left a 10-pin in his first frame, spared it and finished with 11 consecutive strikes. He is currently averaging 191 in the SMCL after 66 games. Paquette doesn't play any other sports but enjoys watching hockey and is a diehard Toronto Maple Leaf fan. In the summer, he likes to get to the Tobermory area as often as possible to relax in the family cottage and enjoy the beauty of the hiking trails.

Bonhomme is high over average:



Robert Bonhomme wheeled 231- 101 pins over average in his second game of the night in the Target Trios League (TTL) at Hi-Way Bowl to take the honours for high over average for one game in LCTA bowling action this past week. Bonhomme works for the railway and at age 36 is a late starter to get involved for the first time (started in February) with the great sport of 10-pin bowling. He recently moved to Sarnia from Northern Ontario and thought it would be a great way to get out, have fun and create a new network of friends. He said he always wanted to throw a hook on the lanes and with his competitive nature this writer believes he will complete his mission. His highest single game is 236. Bonhomme said “being a northern boy, I love fishing, hunting, going out on the SxS, anything outdoor related along with new/old cars and truck”. He has many sporting interests. He played hockey his entire life all the way up



to semi- professional in Finland. He said he played baseball all his life and dabbled in curling, football along with many other team sports. He's an avid golfer and loves chasing that little white ball around the course. He currently bowls full time in the RCAFA league and spares in the TTL and is hoping to acquire full time spots in both leagues next year. Bonhomme said he would like to thank Jeff Wickens and Steve Lewicki for helping him get into a league and spare positions and for getting him fitted with new bowling shoes and a ball. He also wanted to thank Sue Potvin and Shirley Matthews for giving him the opportunity to bowl being so new to the area and so new to bowling. His final comment was that he is looking forward to many years of bowling.
