Bowlers share top triple:

Louie Willemsen and Mike Marciniszyn shared the honours for the top triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week.



Willemsen fired 762 (257-279- 85 pins over average -226 – 180 pins over average for three games) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl. Louie started bowling at age 21 when his wife, who was bowling regularly in a league, encouraged him to join the fun on the lanes. Since then he has been knocking down the pins for 42 years. He has 2-300's and an 811 to his credit. His most memorable event in bowling was when he recorded his first perfect game in the Sunday Morning Men's Classic League at Hi-

Way Bowl in 1989. He tossed his second perfect game in 2009 and then achieved every competitive bowlers dream when he fired 811 in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl in 2011. Louie credits the late Sonny Schofield for helping him the most in developing his game. In the administration part of the game, he has been a board member for 23 years on the local 10-pin bowling association (the old Sarnia and District Tenpin Bowling Association and the new Lambton County Tenpin Association) and also the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association. He also helped coach the junior bowlers at Hi-Way Bowl for 15 years. This year he is bowling in two leagues with his

average in brackets: SMML (200- 63 games) and the BMNML (197 - 54 games). He also spares in the Marcin Thursday Night Men's League.



Marciniszyn rolled 762 (246-258-258) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl. The once a week right handed bowler is holding the top average in the SMML at 227 after 75 games. His closet rival in the league is Matt Salmons at 218 after 45 games. Mike is also leading in the LCTA high average category with his closest competitors being Steve Lewicki who is averaging 224 after 63 in the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League and Dan Chopp who is averaging 223.38 after 78 games in the Marcin Border City Men's League. Mike has a career 8-300's.

Lapointe is a close second:



Ben Lapointe continued his hot streak on the lanes as he wheeled 754 (262-279 – 72 pins over average - 133 pins over average for three games) in the Thursday Night Men's League at Marcin Bowl to take second place in the week's high triple. It was his 26th 700 plus series (15 in adult leagues and 11 in youth leagues) for the high revs, smooth twenty year old right hander. He is one of the many solid bowlers who

have come up through the Hi-Way Bowl and Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling programs.

Renaud takes third place:

Marc Renaud fired 749 (253-269-227) in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to take third place in the week's high triple race. Marc is another right handed bowler who has a ton of revs on his delivery. He has 6-300's and 2-800's (800-801) to his credit. He is currently averaging 222 after 69 games in the TNML.

Lewicki takes fourth spot:

Steve Lewicki rolled 748 (233-247-268) on lanes 11 & 12 in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to take the fourth spot in the week's high triple category. The smooth, high back swing lefty is always a formidable opponent on the lanes and his career bowling achievements back up his bowling skills: 20-300's and 12-800's in the Canadian Tenpin Federation, the defunct American Bowling Congress and the United States Bowling Congress league and tournament action.

Brooker tosses personal best triple:

Mark Brooker tossed 652 (223-234- 127 pins over average for three games) in the Border City Men's League (BCML) at Marcin Bowl to record his personal best high triple. Mark started bowling at age twenty-five and has been bowling off and on for ten years. He is a once a week bowler and has been bonding with the boys in the BCML for the last five years. Mark has been carrying a consistent average in the BCML the last four years (173-179-176-175) and this year he is averaging 176 after 78 games. His personal highest single game is 255. Mark enjoys going to out of town tournaments with the usual gang and usually attends the

Ontario Tenpin Provincial Tournament and the Senior Singles and Senior Doubles Tournaments.

Parkkila has youth high over average:



Cameron Parkkila had a super day on the lanes this past Saturday at Hi-Way Bowl. He hurled 635 (233- 77 pins over average – 203-199 – 167 pins over average for three games) in the Hi-Way Youth Phantom Junior Division to take the honours for the week's youth high over average for three games.
