Creasor strong on the lanes again:

Jim Creasor fired 778 (233-268-277 – 100 pins over average for three games) on lanes 33 & 34 in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl to have another strong night on the lanes and take the honours for the high triple in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week. Creasor is having a solid season this year having rolled 4-750 plus triples in the BMNML. His three other triples include 752 (257-278), 774 (260-269-245) and 784 (279-268-237). He has been within reach three times this year trying to add to his impressive 800 accomplishments. Jim has 25-800's (sanctioned) in the Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF), the old American Bowling Congress and the new United States Bowling Congress bowling associations. He has 13-800's in the CTF, his highest being 876 (299-279-300) which he rolled at Marcin Bowl on October 15, 2015 to set a new city record in the LCTA.



Legault tops for the ladies:

Melissa Legault tossed 680 (287 – 81 pins over average) in the Tuesday Night Ladies League (TNLL) at Marcin Bowl to register the ladies high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action this past week. Legault is a graduate of the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program. She has 14-300's (sanctioned) to her credit in Canadian/American league and tournament competition. She said she has numerous 700's including a 798, 799 and a couple 790's. She has 2 sanctioned 800's (817-812) to her credit both bowled in Port Huron. Melissa holds the honour as the only woman to record 2-800's in the Port Huron Bowling Association history. She is currently averaging

207 after 45 games in the TNLL.

Additional recognition for bowler:

This writer did not have a photo and information available on a youth bowler when last week's bowling report hit the presses. They are now available and additional recognition will be given to Kole Parkkila. As reported in the last bowling report, Parkkila tossed 646 (206-238-76 pins over average – 202 – 151 pins over average for three games in the Phantom Youth Intermediate Division at Hi-Way Bowl. It turns out the feat was his personal highest triple. Kole started enjoying the great game of 10-pin bowling at age 5 in the Hi-Way Bowl Junior Bowlers League in the Bumpers Division. For those of you who are unfamiliar with the "bumpers" term, the lane gutters are blocked off to prevent the bowling ball from entering the channels (gutters). The bumper



bowlers also only bowl two games. Kole is now 16 years old so he has been attacking bowling pins for 11 years even though a couple of those years were 5-pins at Marcin Bowl. Parkkila gives credit to his older brother Justin who got him and his twin brother Cameron back into 10-pin bowling. He said "Justin is a very good 10-pin bowler so he coached my twin brother and me and made sure we had everything we needed to grow as 10-pin bowlers". Kole fired his career high single game 255 at last year's Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association Youth Provincial Championship Tournament at Classic Bowl in Mississauga. He was on a team with his twin brother Cameron, Bryce Watson and Ben Lapointe. The team finished in 2nd place in the "A" Division Boys' Team event. CONGRATULATIONS Kole on great bowling.
