Weekly Highlights

Allen tops his previous high scores:



Jack Allen fired 576 (172-160-244 – 108 pins over average) in the Marcin Bowl Youth League (MBYL) on lanes 15 & 16 in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week to register his career high scores. He beat his previous high scores of 534 and 235 that he bowled the previous week. It was the second week in a row that he bowled 100

pins over average for a single game as last week he tossed 235 (+101). This writer checked back in the LCTA average year books and found Jack first had a sanctioned league average in the 2019-2020 bowling season when he averaged 93 for 60 games in the Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Youth League (HBPYL). In the 2020-2021 season he averaged 114 for 36 games in the MBYL. In the 2021--2022 season he



averaged 123 for 72 games in the HBPYL. This year he is averaging 136 after 28 weeks in the MBYL.

Lefty MacDuff leads the way:



Ralph MacDuff fired 746 (288 - 87 pins over average - 245-213 – 143 pins over average for three games) in the Friday Night Fun Mixed League on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl to lead the way with the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action this past week. It was McDuff’s 3rd 700 this season. MacDuff is averaging 202 in the league after 29 weeks of bowling.

Gauthier has solid week again:



Brandon Gauthier hurled 739 (214-267-258) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (BMNML) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl to take 2nd place in the 700 department this week in LCTA bowling competition. He also tossed 720 (269-267-184) in the Border City Men’s League (BCML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to post the third high triple of the week. They were his 11th and 12th 700’s this

season. It was his second week in a row where he rolled 2-700’s. Last



week he had 726 (245-258-223) and 719 (234-243-242). Gauthier is still in the race for the 700 crown this season but time is running out as he trails Roy Mezzatesta and Ben Lapointe who have 14 each. Gauthier is averaging 211 after 69 games in the BMNML and 236 for 12 games in the BCML as a spare.

Adamson has strong week on the lanes:



Kyle Adamson rolled 717 (255-277 – 68 pins over average – 185) in the Border City Men’s League (BCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to record the fourth high triple of the week in LCTA action. He also tossed 706 (247-238-221) in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to register the sixth high triple of the week. They were his 8th and 9th 700’s this season.

Adamson is averaging 207 for 81 games in the SMCL and 210 for 93 games in the BCML this year.

Creasor holds fifth position:

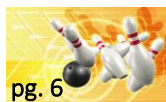
Sheppard played hockey when he was younger and still plays baseball. He also was in stock car racing for a while and has played
