Lapointe is finally perfect:

After 2-298's and 2-299's Ben Lapointe finally conquered the pins twelve times in a row as he smashed his way in posting his career first 300 – 89 pins over average. He was bowling in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) Saturday Hi-Way Junior Bowlers Youth League in the Senior Division at Hi-Way Bowl. He accomplished the feat on lanes 9 & 10 in his second game ending the day with

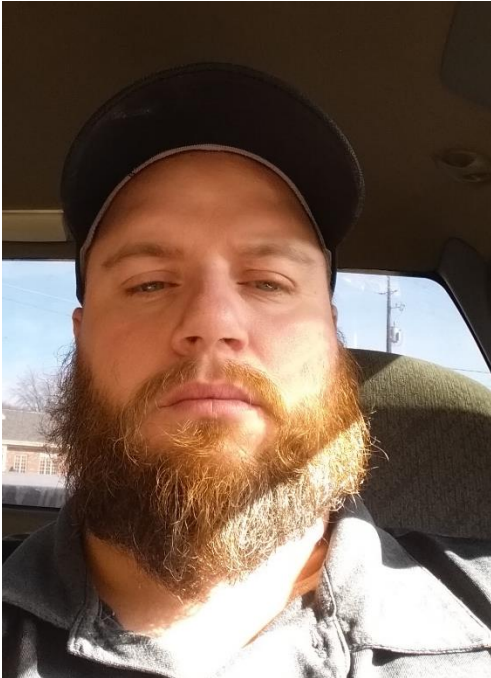


a 740 (268) triple. In his third game he mowed down the pins the first eight frames only to be beat by the right handers dreaded 10 – pin stopping his string of 20 consecutive strikes. The twenty year old now has a career sanctioned 24-700's (13 in Adult leagues and 11 in Youth leagues) in his young bowling life. His highest sanctioned triple is 775. Congratulations Ben from the LCTA on your first 300.

Renaud rolls top triple:

Marc Renaud rolled 780 (278-260-242 – 129 pins over average) in the Thursday Night Men’s League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to record the week’s high triple in LCTA action. Marc started bowling at age 8 in the youth bowling program called “Sports Club 444” at Bowlero Bowl in Windsor and he has been hitting the lanes for twenty plus years. He has a career 6-300’s and 2-800’s (800-801). His bowling achievements include converting the 7-10 split 2 times. The right

hander throws a ton of revs and is currently averaging 219 after 60 games in the TNML.

Armstrong in second place:

John Armstrong rolled 752 (256-270 – 72 pins over average – 226 – 158 pins over average for three games) on lanes 21 & 22 to record the second high triple in LCTA bowling action this past week. He also was fourth best for high over average for the week. John posted the solid series in the Sunday Morning Men’s League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl. John started bowling 10-pin at age 20 and has been knocking the pins down for 19 years. He says bowling is his passion. He has 2-300’s, his first one was in 2009 in Ruthven near Kingsville. He rolled his second perfect game in December, 2018 at Chatham Bowlerama (CB). His career highest sanctioned triple is 792 which he posted in 2009. His most memorable time in bowling was when he rolled

his first perfect game. He has been bowling in CB no tap tournaments over the years and he said “after 12 years I finally won one”. John commutes from Chatham and is in his third year in the SMML averaging 200 after 66 games.



Mezzatesta a close third:

Roy Mezzatesta hurled 745 (254-244-247) in the Target Trios Mixed League (TTML) at Hi-Way Bowl to score the third high triple of the week. Roy started bowling in the Echo Lanes youth bowling program at age 10 under the guidance of coaches Bill Evers, Len Eberle and Lea Eberle. In his early adult life, Roy became a good friend of the late Jim Bourgeois who helped him strengthen his game to become a formidable opponent on the lanes. He has been hammering the pins for over 50 years chalking up many achievements. He was the National Youth Champion at age 12 and has several awards to his

credit over the years including City High Averages (214-229), City High Triple (835 which is now owned by Jim Creasor – 876), LCTA Team Champions and LCTA Double Champions setting a scratch record of 1552 with Jim Creasor in the 2013-2014. He also has 2-800's (highest 835), 8-300's, 13-299's, 2-298's and 2-297's. Asked about his most memorable moment in bowling, Roy said "every time I bowl an honour score". Roy is best known in the Border City Men's League (BCML) for rolling 23 consecutive strikes in his first two games (300-299). In the 1980's and 90's he coached several years in the Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Youth bowling program. This year he is bowling in 4 leagues – TTML, BCML, Hi-Way RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League and the Marcin Bluewater Monday Night Men's League.

Legault is high for the ladies:

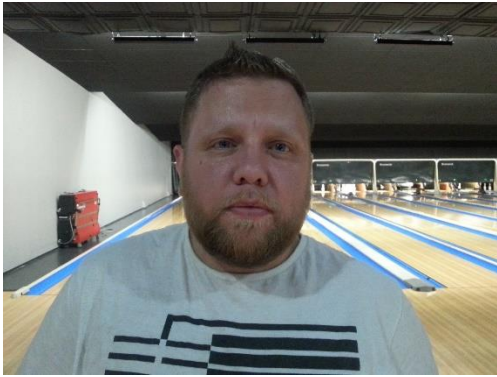

Bill Bennett wheeled 695 (268 – 93 pins over average – 237 – 171 pins over average for three games) on lanes 21 & 22 in the Marcin Sunday Morning Men's League to take the honours for the week's high over average. Bill started 5-pin bowling at age 4 in the Youth Bowling Canada (YBC) and remained there for 12 years. He switched to 10-pin at age 16 out of Starlite Lanes in Wallaceburg and has been enjoying the sport for 21 years. His career highest sanctioned scores are 279 and 748. His most memorable moment in bowling was winning the 1993 Provincial YBC Family Twosome Tournament with his 66 year old

grandfather "Alvin Bennett". Bill said "nothing will top the happiness I seen in that man's face that day. Being a bowler himself since 1940 and to hear him say it was the greatest day of his bowling career was truly amazing." Bill said his greatest achievement in bowling has to be when he rolled 100 games of 5-pin in a 24 hour period. He worked at Starlite Lanes and one of the employee perks was free bowling. One weekend the YBC director organized an All Night Bowl-a-thon where, for a fee, you could be locked in the bowling alley for 24 hours and have unlimited bowling. That day he decided "how cool" it would



be if he could say “I bowled 100 games in a day” and he did it. Twenty years later he is still smiling and laughing over this achievement. He said bowling has been a HUGE part of his life. The friends he made while bowling has carried on for 30+ years. Also it brought common ground between all his family members as they all bowl allowing them all too simply have fun. John said “my goal is to bowl right up until my life on this planet is through and the moment I cross through those pearly gates, hit the lanes once again with my greatest mentor and inspiration for the game –Grandpa”

Stokes records first 700 triple:
