Weekly Highlights

Armstrong shines on the lanes:



Justin Armstrong had a terrific night of bowling this past week. He tossed 679 (245 – 92 pins over average – 260 – 107 pins over average – 174 – 220 pins over average for three games) on lanes 17 & 18 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin bowl to record his career sanctioned highest triple. He was the high over average for a single game and the high over average for

three games in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) this week. He is eligible to receive a Canadian Tenpin Federation watch for being 100 pins over average for a single game. Armstrong's previous high triple was 613 and his high single is 268. Justin is now averaging 160 after 33 games this year in the FTBMNML.

Bonhomme rolls career high triple:

Robert Bonhomme rolled 633 (226 – 67 pins over average – 227 – 68 pins over average – 180 – 156



pins over average for three games) on lanes 33 & 34 in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl to establish a career new high triple. His previous high triple was 604 (198-201-205) which he bowled in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League three weeks ago. Two weeks ago he posted his career high single 266 in the MFFL. Bonhomme is averaging 159 after 14 weeks in the MFFL this year.

VanGrimberghe tops his previous high triple:



Chris VanGrimberghe rolled 568 (186-183-199 – 151 pins over average for three games) on lanes 29 & 30 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl to register his career highest triple in LCTA bowling activity this past week. His previous high triple was 542 which he bowled in the FTBMNML three weeks ago when he also posted his career high game of 209. VanGrimberghe is in his fifth year of sanctioned league bowling. Last year in the FTBMNML he averaged 140 for 51 games. This year in the league he is averaging 146 after 21 games.

Senior Lapointe is the best:



Jim Lapointe hurled 761 (268-257-236) as a spare in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl to record the top triple in LCTA bowling competition this past week. It was his first time sparing in the MFFL this year. It was his 3rd 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously bowled 715 (257-199-259) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) and 700 (248-214-238) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML). Lapointe is bowling full time in the



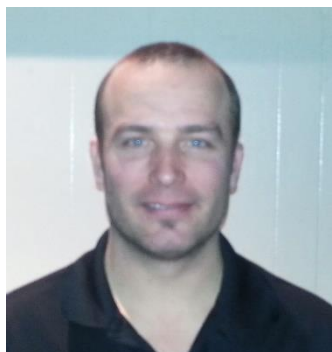
BWCL averaging 212 after 36 games and the FTBMNML averaging 208 after 36 games this year.

White, Ridealgh and Lapointe share second spot:

Mark White, Bill Ridealgh and Jason Lapointe fired 750 triples to tie for second spot in the high triple department in LCTA bowling competition this past week.



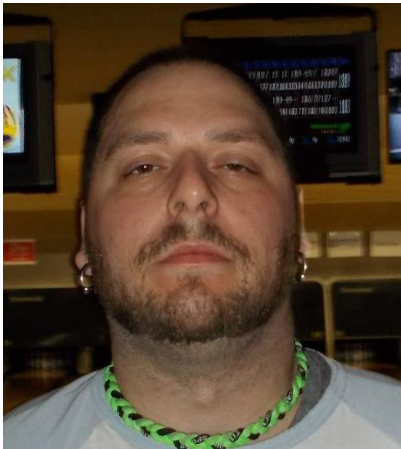
White fired 750 (247-268 – 74 pins over average – 235 – 168 pins over average for three games) on lanes 21 & 22 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl to record his career personal highest triple. His previous sanctioned high triple was 692 which he posted in the Thursday Night Men’s League at Marcin Bowl in October 2019. White also wheeled his sanctioned 295 high triple that night. Mark is averaging 199 after 30 games in the FTBMNML this year.



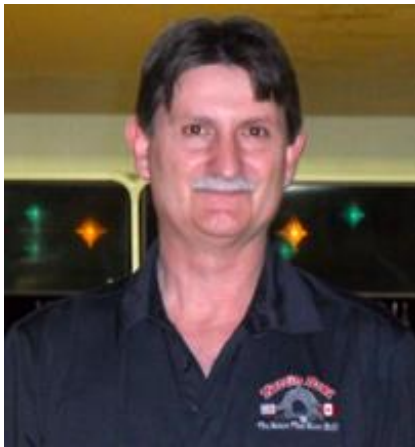
Ridealgh tossed 750 (233-248-269) on lanes 13 & 14 in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl on Sunday morning. It was his 3rd 700 this season in the LCTA as he previously bowled 704 (228-254-222) and 717 (238-227-252). Ridealgh is averaging 215 after 42 games in the BWCL this year.



Lapointe wheeled 750 (235-267-248) on lanes 15 & 16 in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl on Sunday morning. It was his 2nd 700 in the LCTA this year as last week he rolled 725 (277-226-222) in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl. Lapointe is averaging 211 after 36 games in the BWCL this year.

Gauthier nipped to third place:

Brandon Gauthier hurled 749 (267-236-246) as a spare on lanes 23 & 24 in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl on Sunday morning to record the third high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action this past week. It was his 5th 700 this season in the LCTA as he previously bowled 765 (280-259-226) – 702 (233-214-255) – 772 (277-259-236) – 722 (245-246-231). Brandon is averaging 222 after 9 games in the BWCL this year. He only bowls full time in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League and is averaging 214 after 33 games this year.

Ramsay slides into fourth:

Dennis Ramsay bowled 739 (255-257-227) on lanes 25 & 26 in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) at Marcin Bowl to register the fourth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling play. It was his first 700 this season in the LCTA. Ramsay has 2 sanctioned 800's to his credit: 827 (January 31, 2010) and 822 (April 6, 2014). His career sanctioned high single is 300 (3). Dennis is averaging 202 after 33 games in the FTBMNML this year bowling on the "Mike's Hair Styling" team with Mel Matthews, Mike Jones, George Newman and Kirk Ramsay.

Lewicki takes fifth position:

Lefty Steve Lewicki rolled 726 (245-235-246) on lanes 13 & 14 in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) at Marcin Bowl on Sunday morning to capture the fifth



high triple of the week in LCTA bowling activity. It was his 2nd 700 in the LCTA this season as he previously rolled 717 (183-267-267). Lewicki is averaging 204 after 39 games in the BWCL this year.

Junior Lapointe adds to his LCTA 700's:



Ben Lapointe wheeled 724 (257-244-223) as a spare in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to nab the sixth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. He also bowled 717 (212-243-262) as a spare in the Mulder Financial Fun League to record the seventh high triple of the week. It was his career sanctioned 90th and 91st 700 series in the LCTA (75 in adult leagues and 16 in youth leagues) and his 10th 700 this season in the LCTA as he previously recorded 711 – 754 – 766 – 709 – 703 -727 – 730 – 701. This writer does not know how many 700's Lapointe has in USA competition but I'm sure there are a few to count. His LCTA 700 total also does not include any 700's posted in out of town sanctioned Canadian tournaments. This young man throws a ton of revs on his bowling ball and has been rewarded with two tournament victories in Michigan this bowling season.

Smith good for eighth:

Connor Smith rolled 714 (254-213-247) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Marcin Bowl to grab eighth spot in the 700 race this past week. It was his 3rd 700 of the season as he previously bowled 709 (223-241-245) and 716 (275-217-224). Smith is averaging 204 after 39 games in the league this year.



Smith is also bowling full time in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League and is averaging 197 after 39 games.

Watson grabs ninth spot:



Brian Watson fired 711 (232-248-231) as a spare in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl to record the ninth high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his first 700 of the season in the LCTA for the right handed bowler and it was also his first time sparing in the MFFL this year. Watson is bowling full time in two leagues this year. In the Best Wiring Classic League he is averaging 185 after 42 games and in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League he is averaging 188 after 33 games. His career

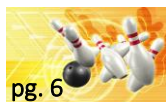
sanctioned high scores are 785 and 300 (3).

after 42 games and in the Sarnia Border City Men's League he is averaging 198 after 45 games.

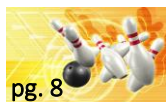

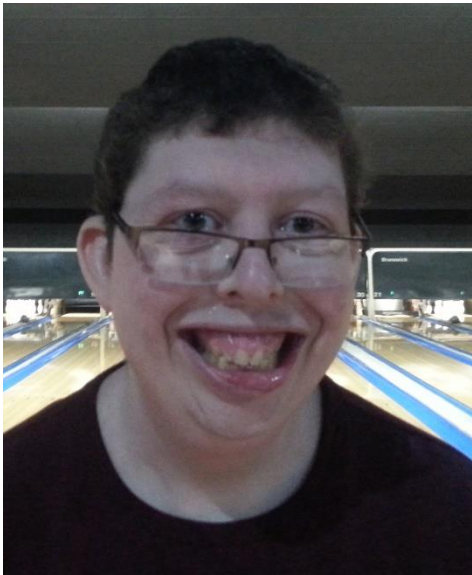
