Weekly Highlights

Plumb is king of the lanes:



Larry Plumb hurled 756 (277-246-233 – 123 pins over average for three games) on lanes 3 & 4 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to take the honours as the king of the lanes for this week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action.

Plumb is averaging 214 after 45 games in the SMCL and has a career sanctioned 7-300's and 6-800's to his credit.

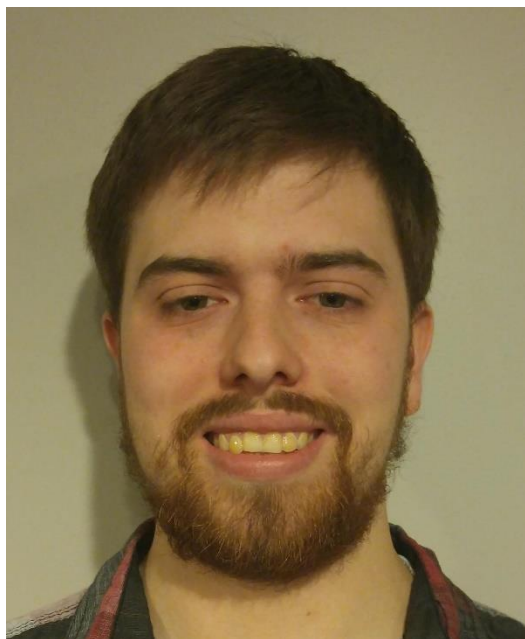
Lapointe takes second spot:

Ben Lapointe tossed 737 (189-269-279) on lanes 1 & 2 in the Target Trios League



(TTL) at Hi-Way Bowl to post the second high triple of the week LCTA bowling action. He also posted a 712 (285-194-233) on lanes 9 & 10 in the RCAFA 403 Wing League to have a solid week on the lanes. The high revs right hander now has 54 – 700 sanctioned triples: 38 in adult leagues and 16 in youth leagues. Lapointe spares in the TTL and is now averaging 222 for 12 games in the league. Lapointe also bowls in two regular leagues with averages and games in brackets: Sunday Morning Classic League (216 for 42 games) and the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League (219 for 30 games).

Smith rolls into third:



Connor Smith rolled 712 (188-255-269) on lanes 7 & 8 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to register the third high triple of the week in LCTA competition. This fine young right handed bowler picked up his bowling skills in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Bowling Program under the watchful eyes of Shirley and Mel Matthews. His highest sanctioned scores are 300 (1) and 815 (258-279-

278) which he rolled in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl in the 2017-2018 season. The pins never had a chance that night as he fired 10 strikes in his first game, 11 strikes in his



second game and 11 strikes in his third game for a total of 32 out of a possible 36 strikes. Smith is carrying a 207 average after 39 games in the SMCL this year.

Lewicki takes fourth:



Steve Lewicki tossed 711 (268-226-217) on lanes 11 & 12 in the Sunday Morning Classic League (SMCL) at Hi-Way Bowl to take fourth place in the high triple department in LCTA bowling activity this week. The

smooth rolling high back swing lefty is averaging 219 after 45 games in the SMCL this year. He has a sanctioned 20-300's and 12-800's to his credit. Lewicki runs his bowling pro shop at Hi-Way Bowl supplying bowling equipment to the competitive bowlers and the ones just out for a night of fun.

Windover posts personal high scores:

Joe Windover rolled the first eleven strikes in his first game of the night. Standing on the lanes with the adrenalin flowing, the heart beats picking up speed, the sweaty hands and deadly silence in the bowling alley with all his fellow bowlers focused on him, he



delivered his last ball of the game coming up high on the head pin. He left the 4-6-7-10 split scoring 296 and was “oh so close” from registering his career first perfect game. For anyone who has been in that situation before, you know the feelings that Joe was experiencing and the disappointment when victory was within reach. Windover was participating in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League on lanes 9 & 10 at Hi-Way Bowl finishing the night with a 644 triple. His 296 and 644 were his career personal highest scores. His previous high scores were 231 and 630. He also recorded 100 pins over average with his 296 which makes him eligible to receive a watch from the Canadian Tenpin Federation. He also took the honours for the LCTA high single of the week. He is averaging 169 for 27 games in the RCAFA league this year. Joe is also bowling in Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Junior League this year averaging 165 for 42 games. Windover started bowling at age 6 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program in the 2010- 2011 and has been knocking down the pins for 11 years. His other sporting interest besides bowling is playing baseball and helping to umpire to keep himself busy in the summer.

Webb fires 100 pins over average:

Ryan Webb fired a 256 on lanes 5 & 6 in his last game of the night in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League to record 100 pins over average for a single game. His effort will reward him with a watch from the Canadian Tenpin Federation. Webb started bowling in

Ryan really enjoys the Friday night league and is looking forward to continuing to improve his game. Last year was Ryan's first year in the RCAFA league and he finished with a 148 average for 30 games in a shortened Covid season. This year, he is now averaging 159 after 39 games. Webb enjoys other sports like baseball, basketball and most recently Cornhole. For you readers that are not familiar with the new sport, Cornhole or Corn Toss is similar to horseshoes except you use wooden boxes called "cornhole" platforms and corn bags instead of horseshoes and metal stakes.
