Belliveau almost perfect:



Pierre Belliveau rolled the first eleven strikes in his second game of the day. Standing on the lanes with the adrenalin flowing, the heart beats picking up speed, the sweaty hands and deadly silence in the bowling alley with all his fellow bowlers focused on him, he delivered his last ball of the game coming

up a shade high in the pocket. The result was the unapologetic 4-pin refusing to fall and not allowing Pierre to post his career second perfect game. His first one came on October 29, 2017 in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl. The left handed bowler from London was bowling on lanes 27 & 28 in the SMML finishing the day with a 664 triple. His 299 (77 pins over average) was good for the high single in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling action this past week.

Lapointe is top bowler:

Ben Lapointe fired 749 (223-247-279 – 110 pins over average for three games) in the RCAFA 403 Wing Mixed League at Hi-Way Bowl to record the high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action. Ben is on a roll this year having shot some great triples so far this year almost half way through the bowling season. He also had a 298 last week in the RCAFA league for his career 6th Honour score. This writer is keeping

tabs on his 700 triples. So now, the twenty year old has 34 - 700's (23 in Adult leagues and 11 in Youth leagues). That is an exceptional feat at his young age. He has really developed his bowling skills in the Hi-Way Bowl Youth Bowling Program.

Dunn is 100 pins over average:

Kevin Dunn tossed 269 – 108 pins over average in his first game of the night in the Thursday Night Mixed League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to take the honours for the week's high over average for a single game. Kevin started bowling 5-pin at Marcin Bowl – Youth Bowl Canada when he was 8 years old. He bowled 5-pin for 11 years and then at age 19 moved out west for 4 years before returning back to Sarnia where he picked up 5-pin bowling once again. Kevin started bowling 10 – pin at age 28 and has been enjoying the sport for 13 years. His personal sanctioned high scores are 298 and 710. He has 1-300 (non-sanctioned).

Dunn's averages for the last nine years in the TNML starting in the 2010-2011 season and working upward were 171 – 176 – 178 – 179 – 193 – 194 – 200 – 186 – 173. This year he is averaging 164 after 45 games.



Youth double tournament champions:

The LCTA Youth Doubles Tournament was held on November 16 & 17 with 36 teams (an increase of 6 teams from last year) participating on the new lanes 25-36 which were installed in the summer time at Marcin Bowl. The ages of the bowlers ranged from 6-20. Some of the youth choose to bowl on both days by changing partners which tuned out in the positive for them in winning scholarship money.

The winning team from Hi-Way Bowl consisted of Elias Ko and Ben Lee. They earned



\$200.00 in scholarship money with their great bowling. Elias is a 2nd year bowler who entered the tournament with a 77 average and rolled 304 (107-131-66 – 73 pins over average for three games. Ben, a



1st year bowler, entered with a 56 average and tossed 274 (92-89- 93 - 106 pins over average for three games). Their combined winning scores with handicap gave them a grand total of 1619 and first place.

The team of Terrell Walker-Gray and Ryan Pinel from Marcin Bowl took 2nd place and



earned \$100.00 in scholarship money. Terrell entered the competition with a 176 average and hurled 619 (193-255-171 – 91 pins over average for three games). Ryan entered with a 187 average and bowled 634 (214-196-224 –



73 pins over average). Their combined scores with handicap gave them a grand total of 1604 which was 15 pins short of victory.



The team of Domenic Coccozoli and Shayla Crouse from Hi-Way Bowl took 3rd place and earned \$40.00 in scholarship money. Domenic entered the tourney with a 172 average and tossed 625 (176-224-225 – 109 pins over average for three games). Shayla entered the race with a 164 average and rolled 544 (173-222-149 – 52 pins over average for three games). Their combined scores with handicap gave them a grand total of 1601 and 3 pins shy of second place.

Fourth place was shared by two teams from Marcin Bowl, each team receiving \$20.00 in scholarship funds. The teams consisted of Terrell Walker-Gray/Dion Maness and Montee Henry/Dion Maness. Both teams ended up with combined scores of 1600 which was 1 pin shy of third place. For Terrell Walker-Gray and Dion Maness, bowling twice paid off.

On the first team, Terrell rolled 524 (177-190-157). Dion entered with a 123 average and fired 533 (188-158-187 – a huge 164 pins over average for three games).

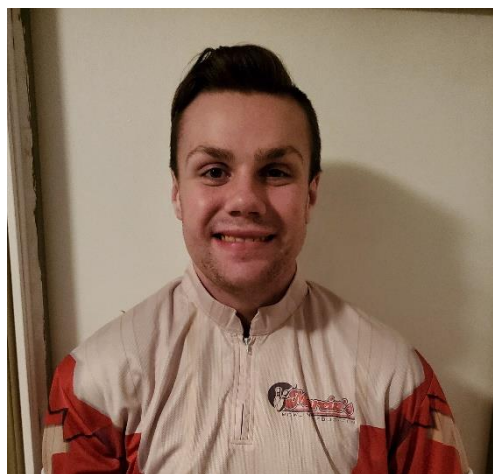
On the second team, Montee entered the competition with a 122 average and wheeled 412 (141-125-146 – 46 pins over average for three games). Dion had another good day on the lanes as he posted 483 (154-191-138 – 114 pins over average for three games).

As a senior bantam, Jacob finished with a



98 average in the 2010-2011 season. He finished last year with a 178 average and this year he is averaging 193 after 42 games.

Olivia Mundy rolled 555 (191-175-189 – 123 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth Senior Division at Hi-Way Bowl to register her personal highest triple. Her personal best single game is 200. Olivia started bowling only 5 years ago at age 13 in the Airey Lanes Youth program at Courtright. When Airey Lanes closed two years ago, she joined the Hi-Way Phantom Youth League and has improved her average from under 100 to her current 144 after fourteen weeks of bowling.
