Lapointe triumphs at youth tournament:

The Ivan Nelson Memorial Canadian Tenpin Federation Youth Tournament was held on January 18 & 19 at Classic Bowl in Mississauga. Lambton County Tenpin Association youth bowler Ben Lapointe, who bowls in the Hi-Way Bowl Phantom Youth Program, was victorious in the Senior Boys Division. His victory qualifies him to represent Team Southern Ontario (TSO) in the Canadian Nationals which will be held on the last weekend in May in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario.



Lapointe defeated 27 opponents over two days to wear the crown. In the Saturday qualifying round, on a modified house shot, he qualified 5th rolling games of 174 – 213 – 179 – 237 – 205 and 256 for a 6 game average of 210. The top qualifier average for 6



games was 246 (300 his last game) followed by 219, 215, 213, 210 (Ben) and 209. The 7th place bowler who didn't make the cut averaged 208. The bowlers advancing to match play competition on Sunday challenged the 38 feet Taj Mahal (sport shot) lane conditions with a point system in place. The top 6 average bowlers advancing to match play had to bowl head to head with each of the other five to earn points by beating their match bowler plus descending points for rolling the highest score of the 6 of them. When it came to the last match game Ben was bowling against the leading point bowler. He realized the only way he could win the tournament was to win the last match and also toss the highest game of all the bowlers. With his back to the wall, under intense pressure, his parents "Jim and Wendy" watching and his TSO coaches including Melissa Legault monitoring the situation, he accomplished what he had to do. In claiming victory, he bowled 5 match play games (234 -215 – 216 – 166 – 227) winning 3 of them earning 27.5 points (1.5 points ahead of his closest competitor) and putting him in first place. Ben averaged 211 for the 11 games he rolled on the weekend. This writer is sure the BLUE BANNER will always help you Ben to replay this memorable weekend in your mind in later years. Shephard almost perfect:



Mike Shephard hurled eleven consecutive strikes in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) at Marcin Bowl only to be beaten by a uncooperative 7-pin ending his game with a 299 to record the high single in Lambton County Tenpin Association bowling action this past week. The accomplishment happened on lanes 27 & 28 in his second game of the night helping him to finish with a solid 757 (299 – 78 pins over average – 258) triple. Shephard is currently averaging 222 after 57 games in the BMNML. Mike has sanctioned scores of 2-299's and 9-300's to his credit.

Youth tops personal high scores:

McKenna Scott rolled 516 (215- 68 pins over average) in the Intermediate Division at Marcin Bowl to beat her personal previous high triple of 515 and register her best high single game. McKenna started bowling 4 years ago at age 12 in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program in the 2015-2016 bowling season. Her final average in the Junior Division for that year was 84. This year she is averaging 147 after 54 games. She is following the footsteps of her father “Paul” who went through the bowling program at Marcin Bowl 35 years ago under the same coaches – Gil and Carol Jean. She has had success in the Ontario Provincial Youth Tournaments (OPYT) over the years. Last year, McKenna and her mother “Johanna” tied for first place in the Ontario Provincial Joyce Woolgar Memorial Family Twosome Tournament in the Adult-Teen Girl Division at Classic Bowl in Mississauga. In 2015, she won the Girls Singles “D” Division in the OPYT and placed 4th in the same tournament the following year. Besides bowling she also keeps herself busy with school work and school sports (curling and badminton).
