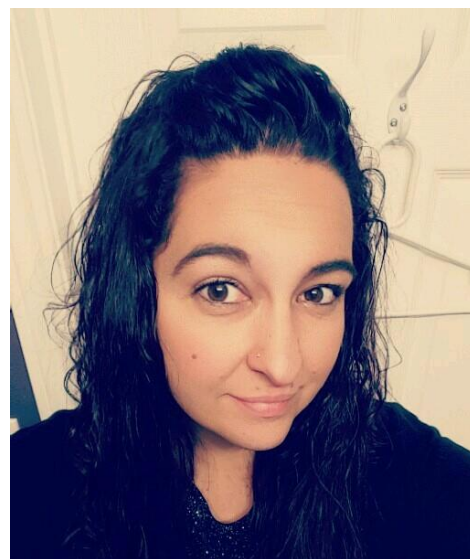
Shephard is perfect:



Mike Shephard hurled a perfect game in the Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) this past week to take the honours for the high single of the week. He registered the gem in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl on lanes 31 & 32 in his first game ending the day with a 684 (300 – 89 pins over average) triple. He now has a career sanctioned 10-300's plus 2-299's and 5-800's. Shephard, a powerful right handed bowler who usually plays around the 10 board area with a lot of speed, is averaging 211 after 42 games in the SMML this year.

Legault rolls ladies' top single:

Melissa Legault fired eleven consecutive strikes in her second game of the night on lanes 17 & 18 only to swing her last shot wide leaving the 2-4-5-7 pins ending with a 296 single. She, like other bowlers who have been in that situation, experienced the disappointment of not seeing all the pins fall on that last shot. She was taking part in the Tuesday Night Ladies League (TNLL) finishing the night with a fine 718 (213- 296 – 89 pins over average - 209) triple which was also good for the ladies high triple of the week. to her credit. These HONOUR scores were recorded in Canadian and American league and tournament action. She is currently averaging 209 after 69 games in the TNLL.

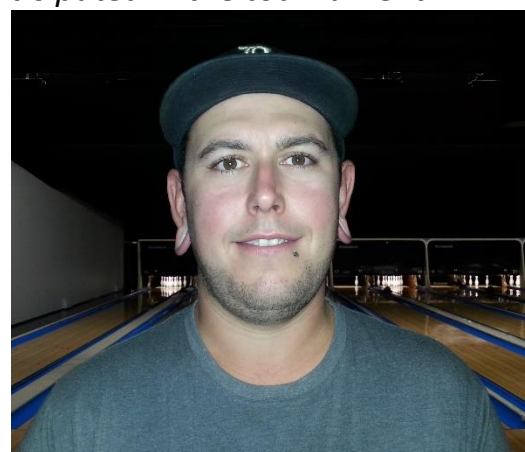

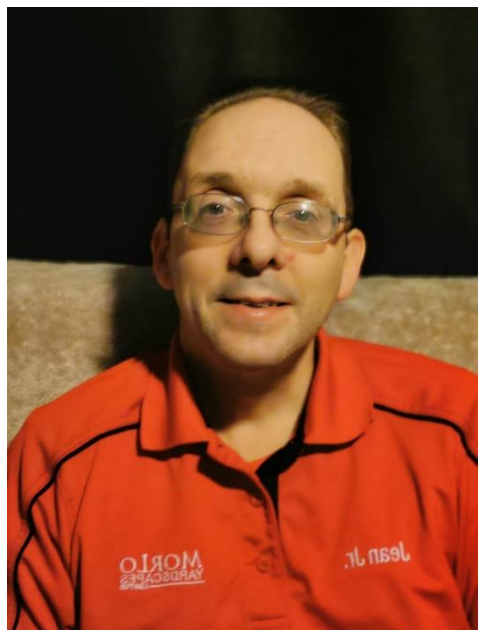
Renaud rolls top triple:

Marc Renaud fired 758 (237-279-242) in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl on lanes 27 & 28 to record the high triple of the week in the Lambton County Tenpin Association. Marc started bowling at age 8 in the youth bowling program called "Sports Club 444" at Bowlero Bowl in Windsor and he has been hitting the lanes for twenty plus years. He has a career 7-300's and 2-800's (800-801) to his



credit. The once a week right handed bowler throws a ton of revs and is currently leading the league in the high average department with 223 after 63 games.

Lacroix takes second place:



Jean Lacroix Jr. wheeled 747 (247-233-267) on lanes 27 & 28 in the Thursday Night Men's League (TNML) at Marcin Bowl to register the second high triple of the week in the LCTA. Lacroix started bowling 5-pin at age seven coming up through YBC (Youth Bowling Canada) program. He initially started the program at the defunct Pin Deck Bowling Alley then transferred to the defunct Northgate Bowl. He bowled 5-pin for 12 years then switched to an adult 10-pin league at Hi-Way Bowl. The team he was bowling on left Hi-Way Bowl in later years and joined the TNML at Marcin Bowl and the rest is history. He has been bowling on the same team for 32 years with two original team members:

Jean Lacroix Sr. and Tony Spano. His career highest triple is 789 and he has 3-300's (sanctioned) to his credit. The right handed bowler is having a great year in the TNML averaging 218 after 75 games.

Adamson nipped into third:



Right handed Kyle Adamson rolled 746 (279-232-235) in the Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (BMNML) on lanes 25 & 26 at Marcin Bowl to record the third high triple in LCTA action this week. Kyle also bowls full time in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) at Marcin Bowl and spares in other leagues as required. This year in the SMML he is averaging 219 for 81 games. Last year in the SMML his final average was 211 for 96 games. This year in the BMNML he is averaging 215 for 78 games while last year in the BMNML he finished with a 205 for 87 games. Scott is fourth best:

Right handed bowler Paul Scott fired 744 (257-242-245) in the Sunday Morning Men's League (SMML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl to post the fourth high triple of the week in LCTA bowling action.
