Weekly Highlights

Crowe rolls top triple again:



Devon Crowe rolled the high triple of the week in Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition for the second week in a row, as he recorded 751 (257 – 53 pins over average – 246 – 42 pins over average – 248 – 44 pins over average – 139 pins over average for three games). He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl. Last week he bowled 759 (256-267-236) in the FTBMNML for his career high triple. He now has 2-700’s for the season and a career 3-700’s. Crowe’s career high single is 289. Devon is averaging 206 for 75 games in the FTBMNML this year.

Mundt tops his high scores:

Brian Mundt bowled 606 (179-227 – 71 pins over average - 200 – 44 pins over average – 138 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s league on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl, to record new high scores topping his previous 603 and 226. Mundt is averaging 158 for 75 games this year. Last year in the league he averaged 157 for 96 games.



Blake wheels new high triple:



Shaylyn Blake wheeled 496 (183 – 54 pins over average – 176 – 47 pins over average – 137 – 109 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to register a career new high triple. Her previous high triple was 483 (211-134-138) which she bowled in the PYL last season. Shaylyn’s high single game is 211. She is averaging 129 after 26 weeks on the lanes. Last year in the league she averaged 132 for 87 games.

Best hurls new personal high scores:



Liam Best hurled 477 (140 – 36 pins over average – 176 – 65 pins over average – 154 – 43 pins over average – 144 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League on lanes 17 & 18 at Marcin Bowl in LCTA bowling action, to top his previous high scores of 371 and 161. Liam is averaging 111 after 26 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the league he averaged 86 for 69 games. Congratulations on the SUPER bowling Liam !!

Meridith posts new high single:



Chris Meridith fired 246 (83 pins over average) in his last game of the night to record a new high single game topping his previous 234. He was participating in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 33 & 34 at Marcin Bowl. Meredith’s career high triple is 580 (215-181-184) which he bowled in the FTBMNML 4 weeks ago. Meredith is averaging 163 for 72 games this year. Last year in the league he averaged 158 for 96 games.



Aitken is 100 pins over average:

Dave Aitken rolled 278 (124 pins over average) in his first game of the night to be 100 pins over average for a single game. He was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl finishing the night with a 587 triple. Dave is eligible for a Canadian Tenpin Federation award for his achievement which is a watch. He also topped his previous high single game of 234. Dave's career high triple is 624 (219-197-208) which he recorded in the FTBMNML this season. Aitken is averaging 156 after 66 games in the FTBMNML this year. Last year in the league he averaged 153 for 84 games.

Lapointe records number nine:

Jim Lapointe fired 740 (257-225-258) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 13 & 14 at Marcin Bowl to post the second high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 9th 700 of the season. Lapointe is averaging 213 for 72 games in the FTBMNML and 219 for 75 games in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) this year. Lapointe is one of ten bowlers to record perfect games in the LCTA this year. He rolled his career 10th 300 in the first week of bowling in the BWCL.

Armstrong holds down last place:

John Armstrong tossed 724 (245 -212-267) as a spare in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men's League (SPBCML) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to record the low 700 of the week in the LCTA. It was his 8th 700 of the season in the LCTA. Armstrong is averaging 224 for 15 games in SPBCML this year. His career high scores are 792 and 300 (2).



Pinel fires ladies high triple:



Marsha Pinel fired 622 (183-204-235 – 66 pins over average) in the Bar 10 Thursday Night Mixed League on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to lead the ladies in the high triple department this past week in the LCTA. Marsha is averaging 169 after 27 weeks of bowling this year. Last year in the league she averaged 163 for 93 games. Marsha started bowling when she was 4 years old. Her parents used to bowl in a mixed league on Wednesday nights and they are the ones that got Marsha, and her two sisters involved in bowling, but Marsha was the only one who really took to bowling and stuck with it. Pinel bowled in the YABA (Young American Bowling Alliance) youth league and remained bowling as a youth for about 6 years. When she was 10, her parents moved out of Sarnia to the country which ended her bowling for a period of about 5 years. When Marsha and her mother “Denise” realized how much they missed bowling they decided to join the Thursday Night Mixed league at Marcin Bowl. They have been bowling in this league consistently for the last 32 years. Her husband “Adam” joined the league and at one point their son “Ryan” joined them for a while on the lanes until he headed off to university. Marsha’s career high sanctioned triple is 719 (237-226-256) which she bowled in the Thursday Night Mixed League at Marcin Bowl in the 2012-2013 bowling season and her high singer is 278.

Allan is top youth bowler:



Jack Allan rolled 616 (209 – 55 pins over average – 206 – 52 pins over average – 201 – 47 pins over average – 154 pins over average for three games) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl, to lead the youth bowlers in LCTA this past week. Jack is averaging 154 after 26 weeks in the PYL this year and 152 for 63 games in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL). Last year in the PYL he averaged 152 for 90 games and 152 for 90 games in the MFFL. His career sanctioned high triple is 651 (234-257-160) and his high single is 257 both recorded in the PYL last season.



Shura nipped to second place:



Joshua Shura tossed 615 (181-222-212) in the Phantom Youth League (PYL) on lanes 23 & 24 at Marcin Bowl to grab the second high triple of the week for the youth bowlers in the LCTA. Shura is having a great year on the lanes this year as he has posted 8-600 plus triples (601-646-642-738-639-642- 665-615). He also bowled his first sanctioned 700 series as he tossed 738 (258-246-234) in the PYL. His career sanctioned high single is 299 (miserable 10 pin) which he posted in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) at Marcin Bowl last season. Joshua started bowling in the Marcin Bowl Youth Bowling Program in the 2015-2016 season in the Preps Division ending the year with a 77 average for 81 games. This year he is averaging 188 after 26 weeks in the PYL. Last year in the league he averaged 180 for 93 games. He is also bowling in the MFFL this year and is averaging 178 for 46 games.

- Open to CTF sanctioned bowlers aged 50 and over (women aged 45 and older).
- All CTF tournament rules and regulations will be in effect.
- Entries should be in by the Friday before the tournament date to ensure lane availability.
- Each bowler will bowl three games on the same pair of lanes.
- This is a handicapped event based on 90% of the bowler's average and 220.
- Bowlers will enter based on their highest sanctioned league average from the 23-24 league season with at least 21 games.
- Bowlers with no average from the yearbook will use their highest current league average of at least 21 games as of the Friday before the event.
- If a bowler does not have a qualifying average, they will bowl scratch.
- Please note that CTF Rule 319(a)-2 (10-pin rule) will NOT be in effect.
- Any player arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning in the frame then being bowled.
NO SCORE WILL BE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.
- When ties occur the prize money will be combined and equally divided among tied positions.
- All questions and disputes will be decided by CTF rules and/or tournament management.
